Welcome to gospel-powered life transformation

- In July of 2016, the Outreach Center at 115 W Bridge Street was purchased, and at this location lunch and snacks were served to the homeless or anyone struggling and needing care.
- In December of that same year Bridge Street Mission incorporated as a church (non-stock corporation) and a board was formed.
- In July of 2017, the former Annabelle Apartments property at 1140 W. Bridge Street was acquired to become a Sober Living Program.
- In 2019 Bridge Street Mission became a 501c3 charity with a policy board.

Currently, the Outreach Center provides a warm location, food, fellowship, practical help and spiritual encouragement for those experiencing homelessness and hunger. It also hosts Celebrate Recovery meetings (similar to AA) and other special events. Our Sober Living Center is a Christian discipleship program providing the support, accountability and skills needed to live addiction free and establish stable and productive lives.

The Process of Life Transformation

There are basically four ways compassionate people attempt to move individuals in need from human suffering to human flourishing:

- 1. Humanitarian aid
- 2. Disaster relief
- 3. Community development
- 4. Life Transformation

The last one, life transformation, is the primary

undertaking of rescue missions like Bridge Street Mission. Our work focuses on breaking the bonds of destructive habits and bad decisions (made by or forced upon the person). The breadth-of-life transformation work can be described with 8 "S" words...

Saved Sober Stable Schooled Skilled Secure Settled Serving

Every one of these "S" words needs to happen in the context of community surrounded by a group of caring individuals. And this is what happens every time a rescue mission is the facilitator of life transformation. Most importantly, spiritual regeneration-entering into a relationship with God through Jesus Christ-is the key to success.
